The NJASL Future Leader Award is given to graduates of library schools in New Jersey who are nominated by a member of the faculty of the school or by a school librarian and member of NJASL with whom they have served an internship. Nominees will be asked to fill out the following application and submit it to the awards and scholarship chair by March 1. Four future leaders will be chosen from based on their application and essay. The future leader agrees to serve a minimum of one year on an NJASL committee. He/she will receive membership in NJASL for one year, conference admission for the fall after they are selected, and attendance at our spring meeting which would include dinner.
