

Elaine Huray Memorial Scholarship

The Elaine Huray Memorial Scholarship, sponsored by the Morris County School Media Association, will be awarded in May of 2006 to an individual who is attending Rutgers SCILS to obtain an MLIS degree in the field of educational media. The scholarship is a one-time grant of \$2500.00. The candidate must:

- 1) possess a New Jersey teaching certificate or valid out-of-state-instructional license
- 2) be currently enrolled at Rutgers with the intention of becoming a school library media specialist or have proof of acceptance in the MLIS program..

The applicant must provide copies of certifications, current resume, a description of educational background and a brief statement of achievements and plans for a future position in educational media. Recommendations from one professional educator must accompany the application. Application deadline is March 1, 2006. Finalists will be interviewed.

Preference will be given to someone either living or working in Morris County.

Elaine Huray passed away in November 2004, following a long career as an educator and library media specialist at Parsippany High School. She was an enthusiastic supporter of school library programs and a mentor to new librarians. The scholarship has been made possible by the generosity of her loving family, colleagues and friends to encourage others who wish to be part of the profession.

The award will be presented at the May 2006 MCSMA general meeting.
